Camp Central – Job Description

We'll have 3 people on our Camp Central crew, including the Camp Central Director.

Camp Central is where lots of the activity happens in camp. Our retail operation is here, as well as information, snacks, first aid, lost and found, etc. Participants congregate in the Camp Central area to visit and relax.

This position requires:

- Good people skills
- Team players
- Strong communication skills
- Flexibility and diplomacy
- The ability to do physical labor, including lifting and moving heavy boxes
- An enjoyment of being with people and a strong customer-service ethic
- Making rational on-the-spot decisions
- An upbeat personality
- The willingness to step in and do whatever is necessary to get the job done
- A current Food Handler's Permit (we will pay for you to get this)

Camp Central duties include, but are not limited to:

- Assist in picking up supplies that have been ordered at local stores
- Set up and tear down camp Camp Central area, with Infrastructure team
- Maintain some camp functions and equipment:
 - Water station
 - Sunscreen, hand sanitizer, bug spray
 - Device charging station
- Ensure snacks are kept stocked for riders and crew

Before the first day of riding:

If you're available, you may be asked to assist in picking up equipment and supplies. You may also be asked to clean and load equipment at the end of the ride.

After the last day of riding

End-of-ride clean-up includes cleaning all equipment before it's reloaded or returned.

Amenities

- Crew members will receive exclusive event gear
- We'll provide lunch in Cleveland Commons on each day you work
- You'll have access to other amenities available to the riders (snacks, beverages, etc.)
- You can ride in either BRNW 2026 week-long tour for 50% off

For this to work, it's critical that you be a TEAM PLAYER, and be pleasant at all times. The reason we all do this – crew and riders – is to have fun!
