Route Crew Job Description

The Route Team is made up of two people – “route setter” and the “route picker” person.

The route positions require:

- Good navigation and driving skills
- Strong organizational skills and attention to detail
- Clear and collaborative communication
- Flexible thinking
- The ability to do physical labor, including lifting and moving equipment
- Enjoying being around many people
- Making rational on-the-spot decisions
- An upbeat nature and customer-service focus
- The willingness to step in and do whatever is necessary to get the job done
- A current driver’s license and the ability to drive a rental vehicle
- A clean driving record

Route crew duties include, but are not limited to:

Setter

- Mark the routes: spray marks the day before, physical signage the morning of
- Follow the cue sheets and mark turns and other necessary areas if there is something of danger on the road
- Make notes where there are any changes needed to the route plan, and report back to the Event Director
- Leave camp before the riders and sign the route so you stay in front of the first rider
- Remove hazards in the road such as rocks, gravel, piles of booze bottles, etc.
- Mark hazards such as bad potholes, cattle guards and loose gravel
- Try to find a way to get potential bad dogs put in a house or yard or tied up
- Notify the Event Director of any hazards or changes in road conditions, if necessary
- Gather signage from route picker each evening

Picker

- Picking up route signage each day and deliver to camp
- Working the route each day, helping support crews as needed
- Deliver route signage to the Route Director in camp each evening

Sunday, Day 0:

You may be asked to help unload and organize equipment, and pick up rental vehicles.

Saturday, Day 6

At the end of the event ride, you may be asked to load equipment onto the transport trucks.

Amenities

- Crew members will receive exclusive event gear
- We’ll provide lunch in Cleveland Commons on each day you work
- You’ll have access to other amenities available to the riders (snacks, beverages, etc.)
- You can ride in either BRNW 2026 week-long tour for 50% off

For this to work, it’s critical that you be a TEAM PLAYER, and be pleasant at all times. The reason we all do this – crew and riders – is to have fun!
