### **Bellingham**

This place is not at all fancy, but it's the highest-rated property with reasonable rates that's decently close to our site at Fairhaven Middle School (10 minutes away). Rooms are about \$120, and you can call them directly at 360-671-9000 and mention the bike tour.

*Wednesday and Thursday, July 15-16*

*There is no lodging available in Kendall; the nearest reasonably priced, nice property is in Lynden, about 20 miles from camp.*

It's about 30 minutes from our camp at Kendall Elementary, so we'll be doing limited, specifically timed runs between camp and lodging.
