

## **Bike Camp Walla Walla Rest Stops – Job Description**

We'll have a total of 7 people on the Rest Stop team, including the Rest Stop Director. The group will be split into two teams of three for each of the two rest stops each day. Each team will need one person who can drive a 20-foot truck with an attached toilet trailer. It's hard work, and the hours are long – but it's a challenge that will hopefully give you a sense of satisfaction after doing it well.

### **This position requires:**

- Good people skills
- Ability to work well with crew members of all ages and backgrounds
- Communicating well
- The ability to do physical labor, including lifting and moving equipment
- Flexible thinking
- Diplomacy and tactfulness with crew, riders and vendors
- Enjoying being with people
- Making rational on-the-spot decisions
- Being upbeat
- The willingness to step in and do whatever is necessary to get the job done
- Driving a box truck with an attached trailer (one person on each team)
- A current valid driver's license (if driving a vehicle)
  - A clean driving record
- A current Food Handler's permit (we will reimburse you for this)
- Current First Aid/CPR certification (we'll pay for training if needed)

### **Rest Stop duties include, but are not limited to:**

- Assist in picking up supplies that have been ordered at local stores
- Assist in set-up and tear-down of rest stops
- Ensure that drinks and snacks are kept stocked for riders and crew
- Ensure that rest stops and equipment are kept clean
- Ensure that the rest stop area is cleaned up before leaving

### **Amenities**

- Crew members will receive exclusive event gear
- We'll provide lunch in Cleveland Commons on each day you work
- You'll have access to other amenities available to the riders (snacks, beverages, etc.)
- You can ride in either BRNW 2026 week-long tour for 50% off

***For this to work, it's critical that you be a TEAM PLAYER, and be pleasant at all times. The reason we all do this – crew and riders – is to have fun!***
